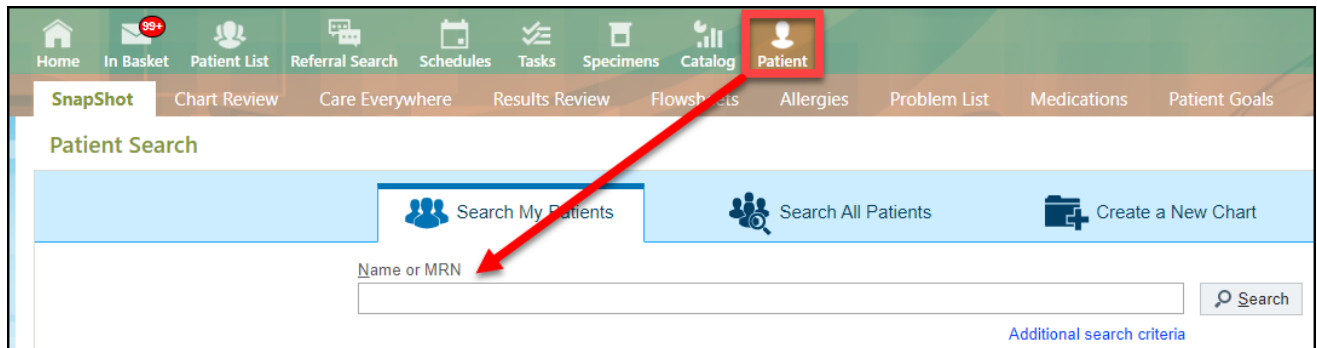


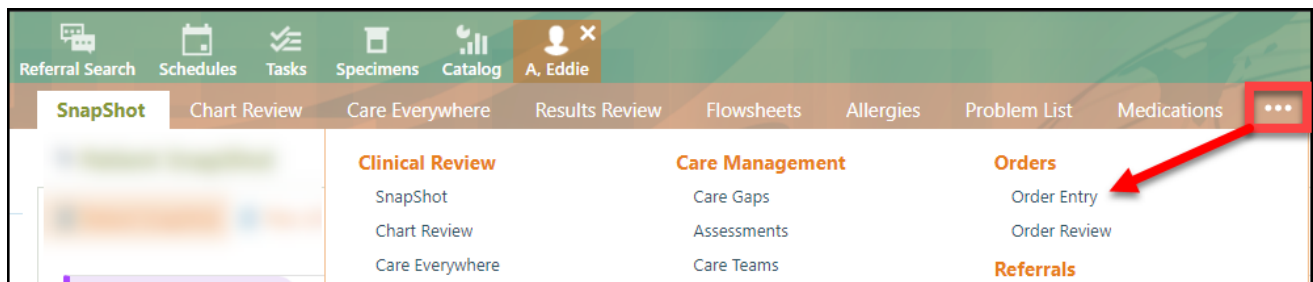
EpicCare Link: E-Consult to Wound Care

Try It Out

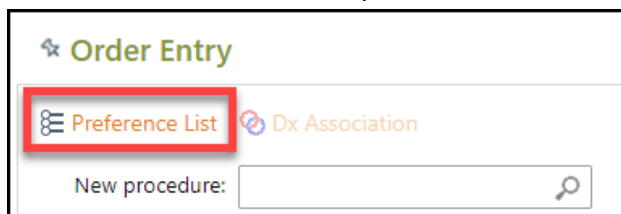
1. Select the **Patient** tab. This appears across the top toolbar.
2. Search and select the desired patient.



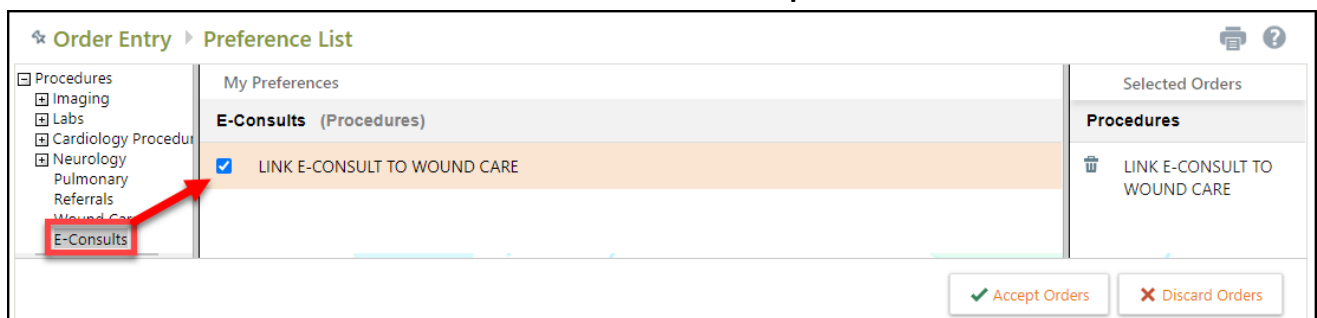
3. Open the More Menu (three dots) and select **Order Entry**.



4. Select an **Ordering Clinic** and an **Authorizing Provider**. Click **Accept**.
5. Select **Preference List**. The preference list will show you all orders that are available for your site.



6. From within Preference List, use the left column to find and select the category **E-Consults**.
7. Check the box for **Link E-Consult to Wound Care**. Click **Accept Orders**.



8. Enter relevant information regarding the e-consult into the **Comment** section.
 - Include a picture or other form of media in the **Attach Files** section.
 - Associate a diagnosis in the **Dx Association** section.
