

Update to the Modified Visitor Policy at United Regional (includes the Hospital, Emergency Department, URPG Clinics and CarePlus Clinic)

United Regional will continue to modify its visitor policy as needed, adapting accordingly to protect the health of our patients, visitors, staff, and community - and to prevent the potential spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). Effective **Friday, April 1, 2022**...

Visiting Schedule

- **Hospital visitation hours:** 7 a.m. to 9 p.m., 7 days per week
- **URPG Clinic hours:** Monday – Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- **CarePlus Clinic hours:**
 - Barnett Road Medical Building: 7:30 a.m. to 7 p.m., 7 days per week
 - Burkburnett: **Effective April 4, 2022 - open Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays: 8 a.m. - 5 p.m.**

What You Need to Know Before Visiting

- Designated entry points to the hospital will be at United Regional's Bridwell Tower and Emergency Department.
- All **hospital** visitors (including outpatients, vendors and contractors) will go through a brief screening process to include a temperature check and questions re: symptoms and potential exposure. Those cleared through the screening process will receive a color-coded wristband, which must be worn and visible throughout the hospital.
- **All URPG clinic patients and visitors are to self-screen prior to coming to their appointments.**
- System-wide, visitation will be limited to two visitors per non-COVID patient, of which one visitor may be under the age of 18. The minor must be accompanied by an adult (18 years or older) visitor, and all visitors two years of age or older must wear a properly fitting mask. Staff may not have visitors at this time.
- Patients in isolation who are under investigation or positive for COVID-19 are allowed one adult visitor (18 years or older) per day. Visitation hours are from 12 - 6 p.m., 7 days a week. Once a visitor leaves the patient's room, he or she must exit the hospital immediately and cannot return that day. If the patient is a minor, the minor will be allowed to have one parent/guardian with them. These visitors will be required to wear personal protective equipment in the patient's room. Personal belongings may be dropped off at screening locations, however no outside food is allowed.
- One adult visitor per day will be allowed to accompany symptomatic patients who present to the Emergency Department and CarePlus.
- For **hospital** patients who are in isolation for other reasons, visitation will be limited to two adult (18 years or older) visitors per patient. These visitors will be required to wear personal protective equipment in the patient's room.
- Any visitors (unless seeking medical attention) who are sick or do not meet screening criteria will be asked to leave the facility and instructed on how to seek medical attention (i.e., calling their health care provider, by scheduling a virtual visit through [MyChart](#); or scheduling an appointment at the CarePlus clinic.
- Age restrictions do not apply to visitors 18 and under who present in the Emergency Department or CarePlus (as the patient or with a patient).

There will be very limited case-by-case exceptions to this policy (regarding number of visitors) for areas such as Pediatrics and Labor & Delivery and for such situations as end-of-life care. Please know, United Regional is committed to our patients, visitors, staff and community. We are working diligently to ensure the highest level of health, and health care, for all. Thank you for your cooperation during this time, and thank you for entrusting us with the care of your loved ones.
